Vision

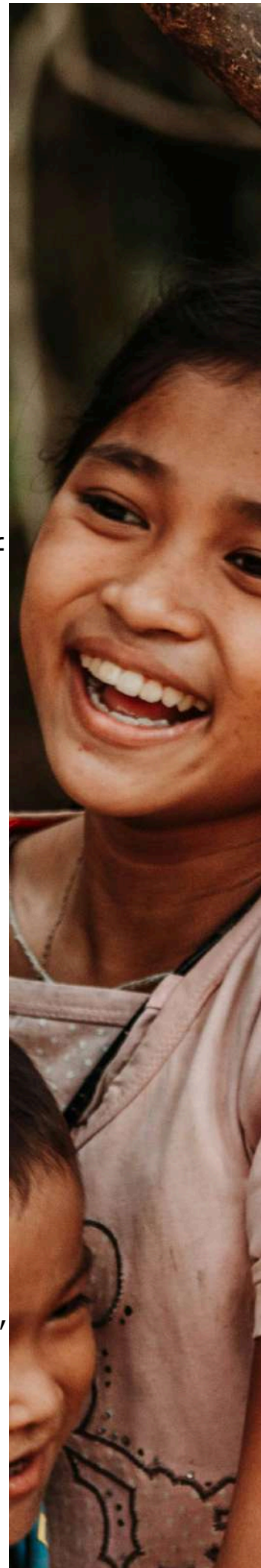
To build a healthier, more informed, and empowered society through community-driven initiatives.
